

Are you constipated from your prescription pain medication?



You may be able to take part in a clinical research study investigating a new drug for constipation caused by prescription pain medication (opioid-induced constipation).

Eligible volunteers must:

- Be aged 18 to 84 years old
- Have been taking prescription pain medication for chronic pain (non-cancer related) for at least 8 weeks
- Not be pregnant or breast feeding

Eligible volunteers receive study-related:

- Physical examinations
- ECGs (tracing of your heart's rhythm)
- Laboratory tests
- Investigational drug
- Compensation for your time and travel
